MAJOR

The curriculum in psychology provides a flexible program for the psychology major leading to the Bachelor of Science Degree. All majors take basic coursework in abnormal and developmental psychology, behavioral neuroscience, statistical methods and research design.

MINOR

Students can earn a minor in psychology or take advantage of the numerous course offerings that are offered to all students.

CAREERS

A Bachelor of Science degree in psychology prepares students for graduate study in psychology. The degree also provides a strong foundation for a variety of careers in areas such as teaching, counseling, social work, sales, management, personnel administration, ministry, law, politics, psychiatry, nursing, medicine, optometry, public health, and physical and occupational therapy.

BY THE NUMBERS

The UAB Psychology Department has a solid history of growth and accomplishment. Each year the department graduates over 180 students with a B.S. degree (over 160 in psychology and 20 to 30 in neuroscience), and around a dozen students with a Ph.D. The department has 31 primary faculty members and over 75 secondary, adjunct, and clinical faculty members who provide a wide assortment of research, clinical, and academic opportunities in a variety of settings.
